to become a Television and Radio Consultative Group member

Introduction

The Television and Radio Consultative Scheme (The Scheme) was introduced in 1982 to help the Television and Entertainment Licensing Authority (TELA) (the Broadcasting Division of TELA is now the Broadcasting Authority (BA) Secretariat) gather public opinions on broadcasting contents for formulation of broadcasting rules that can reflect community standards.

Members join the Scheme on a voluntary basis for a two-year term. They are recruited by the BA Secretariat with reference to the population profile of age, sex and occupation of different districts in Hong Kong.

Activities

The BA Secretariat will invite Members to provide their views on broadcasting standards via email, telephone, etc., or to participate in focus group meetings at TELA at Revenue Tower, Wan Chai for in-depth discussions. Functions will be organized to enhance Members' understanding of the Hong Kong broadcasting industry.
